Lisle, IL – On January 15 at the monthly meeting of the Lisle Park District Board of Park Commissioners, the 2014 Photography Contest winners were announced, including awards for first place, second place, third place and honorable mention.

The highest award for first place was presented to Lisle resident Eileen Kosar for her breathtaking photograph of the shadows casted by the landscape in *Lisle Community Park* as the sun set over the water. Eileen’s photo is now on display in the Lisle Park District Recreation Center lobby at 1925 Ohio Street. The honor for second place was awarded to Janae Kinn, a 22 year-old Lisle resident, for her fun-loving portrait of a canine friend resting in the vibrant leaves at *Lisle Community Park*. Last but certainly not least, honorable mention was given to Mary Harmon, Lisle resident, for her close-up portrait at *Lisle Community Park* of a serene butterfly resting on pink flower buds.
