Lisle, IL – Thank all past, present and future veterans in a meaningful way by supporting the Lisle Veterans Memorial Fund, a grass roots effort that was started in the greater Lisle community to construct a monument honoring veterans while promoting civic pride.

In partnership with the Lisle Park District, Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation, and the Village of Lisle, several community members have united to support construction of a more visible Military Veterans Memorial on the southeast corner of School Street and Center Avenue near The Museums at Lisle Station Park in Downtown Lisle. Construction of the memorial cannot advance without 100% funding, which will begin this summer and is projected for completion by Veteran’s Day, November 11. The main objectives of the memorial are to provide a place of reflection and remembrance that is attractive, durable, easy to maintain, visible from the street, and immediately recognized as a Veteran’s Memorial.
