Lisle, IL – Lisle Park District's 2nd Annual Summer Entertainment Series has an eclectic line-up of local bands to please every music lover this summer.

After a successful first year, the free Summer Entertainment Series is back again, beginning mid-July. The four-week series will feature a different band each week at Lisle Community Park's Van Kampen Memorial Stage (1800 Short St., Lisle), beginning on Wednesday, July 17 from 7-8:30pm.

Everett Dean & Lonesome Hearts will kick things off on July 17 with their rockabilly, hip-hop and electronic style. Anthem, a classic rock and beyond cover band, will play July 24. Boy Band Review, a boy band tribute band, will take the stage on July 31, and local favorite Call Me Jo (formerly Next Tuesday Band) will play acoustic versions of pop, rock, and country hits on August 7. All performances are from 7-8:30pm.

Each concert will have food and drinks available for purchase. Lisle High School's parking lot will be closed for construction, but free parking will be available at Sea Lion Aquatic Park (1825 Short St., Lisle), Community Center (1825 Short St., Lisle), and Recreation Center (1925 Ohio St., Lisle). Overflow parking will be available at Tee Time Golf Range (1400 Maple Ave.,) for a nominal fee. Bring your friends and family of all ages, lawn chairs, and blankets, and come out to enjoy a great line up of live music this summer!
