The merry fun continues on Sunday, December 4, from 11am-4pm, when Santa and his jolly misses bring their live reindeer for a special visit south of the Pole! Santa Claus is expected to stop by with more holiday treats. Save when you pre-register by December 7! Fee is \$5 per resident and \$8 per nonresident when you sign up by December 7. Registration is accepted on-site for \$10 the day of the event.
