### THE DIRECTOR

We have had a busy summer and look forward to maintaining that momentum right into the Autumn months. The most notable ongoing project has been our Indoor Recreation Space Feasibility Study. This has been reported in previous program guides, on social media, our annual newsletter, through email and elsewhere so hopefully this is not news to you. Our consulting group, PROS Consulting, has concluded the public engagement portion of the study and will be making a presentation to the Board of Park Commissioners at their regular meeting of August 21. Here we will learn the outcome of the public process and the community's preferences as they relate to indoor recreation. If you have not already participated in the online survey or your household was not one selected at random to participate in the statistically valid survey, you still have time to let your thoughts be known via an online survey that can be accessed from our project specific website until August 18 at bit.ly/lisleparksfeasibilitystudy.

As you may already know, we switched gears again with the restaurant at River Bend Golf Club earlier this summer. In the 20+ year history of restaurant operations at our park district, we have had four different iterations of a full-service operation and unfortunately all four have failed in one way or another. As a result, and to limit our financial risk, we have downsized the food operation significantly to focus primarily on our golfing patrons. Of course we welcome others who are looking to socialize with friends, watch sporting events on one of the several TVs, or just stop in to enjoy the beautiful views of the golf course. The dining room remains available to rent for private events like bridal and baby showers, religious celebrations, graduation and retirement parties, funeral luncheons, class reunions and more, so consider River Bend Clubhouse as a host site for life's important milestones. For a quick peek into the new operation, visit riverbendgolfclub.org.

Looking ahead at programs and events, you will notice the autumn months are full of exciting and engaging opportunities for all ages. We have six different computer/gaming program and design classes in our "Teens" section. But don't let "Teens" fool you as several options are open to ages 7-13 and 11-16. Our collaborative event with the Lisle Heritage Society, Depot Days, is scheduled for September 20 and 21 at The Museums at Lisle Station Park and is always a great way for adults and children alike to learn the ways of our forefathers through interesting exhibits and interactive demonstrations. We continue to expand our nature programming through cooperative efforts with the Downers Grove Park District and are offering 18 NEW nature programs! 2025 will be the second year of our new winter events including Peppermint Path, Winter Wonderment, and Santa Express. In fact, we are offering three time slots for Santa Express to help accommodate the overwhelming demand from last year, so be sure to reserve your spot early!

We remain dedicated to our mission of "Be community focused" as we continue to evolve services, programs and events, especially, as we work with you to determine next steps regarding indoor programming space. As always, we truly appreciate your trust and confidence and look forward to continuing this great work together.

#### WITHDRAWING FROM EDGE

If you no longer need your child enrolled in EDGE or you would like to drop days from the following month that you later discover you do not need, you will be required to go into your account and manually drop the days before the  $20^{\mbox{\tiny th}}$  day of the current month.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Are you looking for some help to pay for programs? The Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation supports the mission of the Lisle Park District and recognizes the need within the community to provide assistance to residents who otherwise cannot afford to participate in Park District programs. This financial assistance program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation who provide scholarship funds for Lisle Park District families who exhibit a financial need for assistance in order to enroll in recreational programming through the Lisle Park District.

- The waiver of program fees is available to Lisle Park District residents only. All programs are eligible for assistance.
- Income eligibility for Lisle Park District's waiver of program fees is based on the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services Poverty Guidelines.
- An applicant must supply the Lisle Park District with documentation of any forms of income he or she is currently receiving i.e. recent pay stub, AFDC case #, a copy of a recent IRS 1040 form, etc.
- Each eligible individual may apply the fee waiver to register for any park district program with a limit of \$750 per year for up to a family of four, with additional funding of \$190 per year for each additional child. This program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation. Funding is subject to availability of funds.
- A waiver of program fees may be issued for 6 months, but the applicant must reapply at the end of the time frame granted in order to continue participation in the program.

#### **APPLICATION PROCESS**

To be considered for financial assistance you will need to fill out our application, briefly describe what makes you and/or your family eligible, a list of the recreational programs that are of interest to you and/or your family, and a list all the persons living in your home for whom you provide support.

Include documentation (i.e. pay stub, AFDC case #, copy of IRS 1040 form)

Complete program registration form and attach to application

Please allow 7 days for review of this application. Lisle Park District reserves the right to approve partial funding or deny an applicant's request.


