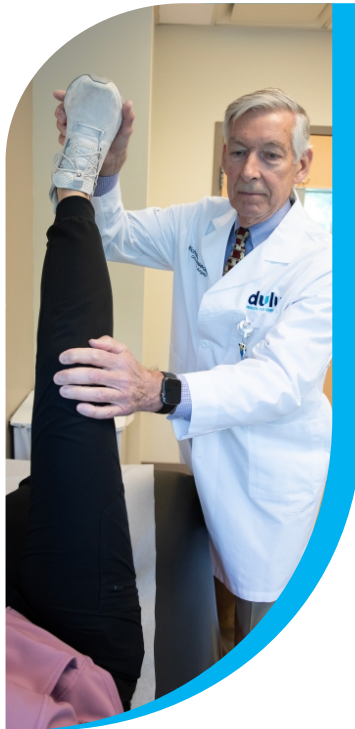

GREETINGS FROM

THE DIRECTOR

The proposed Community Activity Center continues to be an important focus for the Park District. Shaped by community input, the concept centers on the amenities and programs residents value most, along with spaces that can be responsibly supported through memberships, rentals, and program revenue.

This work began after the Lisle Park District's 2023 Strategic Master Plan identified its top recommendation of, "Develop additional indoor, multigenerational recreation space."

The 2025 Indoor Recreation Space Feasibility Study built on that direction by asking residents which indoor recreation programs and amenities matter most. Through focus groups, a statistically valid community-wide survey, facility planning, and financial analysis, the study found strong support for new indoor recreation space and concluded the facility could be self-sustaining if developed and operated responsibly.

Since then, the Park District has continued listening, sharing information, and refining the concept. The next phase included help from architects, a project and construction management firm, civil engineers, and a public affairs and pre-referendum consulting group. Together with this group, the Park District has presented facility design renderings, programming opportunities, cost estimates, public information sessions, business plan, referendum considerations, tax impact analysis, and voter opinion survey. The results of this voter opinion survey revealed ongoing support from the community, but also tax sensitivity and economical concerns.

The Board of Park Commissioners is expected to consider placing a referendum question on the November 3, 2026 ballot at its regular monthly meeting on Monday, August 10, 2026.

In other Park District news, the Community Park Basketball Court renovations are complete, and new equipment has been installed at the Ramp Park. Plans are also moving forward to replace the Community Park South Picnic Shelter, which has served the community since 1989, with a larger facility for summer camps, special events, and private rentals. Construction is scheduled to begin the second week of August and be completed by Thanksgiving.

We also have a wonderful lineup of autumn events and programs planned. Take a look through the following pages for plenty of ways to stay active, connected, and engaged this fall!

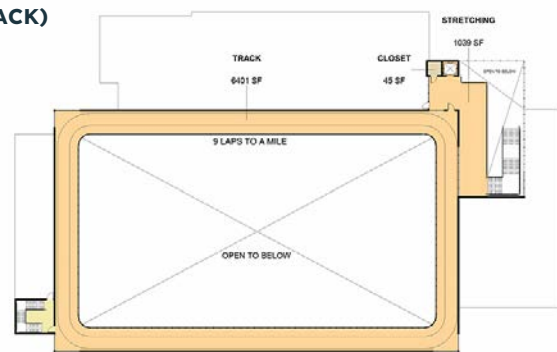

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

FOR LISLE PARK DISTRICT PROGRAMS

Are you looking for some help to pay for programs? The Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation supports the mission of the Lisle Park District and recognizes the need within the community to provide assistance to residents who otherwise cannot afford to participate in Lisle Park District programs. This financial assistance program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation who provide scholarship funds for Lisle Park District families who exhibit a financial need for assistance in order to enroll in recreational programming.

- ▶ The waiver of program fees is available to Lisle Park District residents only. All programs are eligible.
- ▶ Income eligibility for Lisle Park District's waiver of program fees is based on the Illinois Department of Commerce Income Eligibility Guidelines.
- ▶ An applicant must supply the Lisle Park District with documentation of any forms of income he or she is currently receiving – i.e. recent pay stub, AFDC case #, a copy of a recent IRS 1040 form, etc.
- ▶ Each eligible individual may apply the fee waiver to register for any park district program with a limit of \$750 per year for up to a family of four, with additional funding of \$190 per year for each additional child. This program is funded by the Lisle Partners for Parks Foundation. Funding is subject to availability of funds.
- ▶ A waiver of program fees may be issued for 1 year, but the applicant must reapply at the end of the time frame granted in order to continue participation.

APPLICATION PROCESS

To be considered for financial assistance you will need to fill out our application, briefly describe what makes you and/or your family eligible, a list of the recreational programs that are of interest to you and/or your family, and a list all the persons living in your home for whom you provide support.

- ▶ Early registration along with a request for ADA accommodation or inclusion assistance in any program is required at the time of registration and at least two weeks prior to the program start date.
- ▶ Please fill out the assistance or accommodations section during online registration or on our registration form. Requests include but are not limited to: Inclusion Aides, Sign Language Interpreters, Adaptive Equipment, and Accessible Transportation.
- ▶ Parent/guardian will be contacted within 48 hours of registration to discuss and determine level of support needed. We will do our very best but can't guarantee an aide will be secured prior to the program start date.
- ▶ If we are able to secure an aide, SEASPAR (South East Association for Special Parks & Recreation) or the Park District will contact you.

We apologize for any inconvenience these adjustments may cause. Your understanding and cooperation are appreciated.

REGISTER BY DATES HOW TO AVOID LATE FEES

The register by (Reg. By) date indicates the last day registration will be taken for programs. Any registrations accepted after the register by (Reg. By) date will be charged a \$5 late fee, unless otherwise noted.

PROOF OF RESIDENCY

A Lisle Park District resident applies to those persons residing within the boundaries of the Lisle Park District, as well as immediate family members living within that household. The fees listed in this brochure are for Lisle Park District Residents (R) & Nonresidents (NR).

NON-SUFFICIENT FUNDS

There will be a \$25 service charge assessed for all electronic funds transfer (EFT) and checks returned for non-sufficient funds.

PROGRAM CANCELLATION & REFUNDS

The Park District reserves the right to cancel, postpone or combine classes, or change instructors. Programs that do not reach the minimum enrollment numbers will be cancelled. Cancellation of programs is made three days prior to the program start date, whenever possible. In the event that the Park District cancels a program, the participant will receive a full refund. If a program is cancelled in mid-session, a prorated refund will be issued.

No refunds will be made once a program has begun unless the Park District has altered or cancelled a program, or if the "Satisfaction Guaranteed" policy is implemented. If you need to drop-out of a program there will be a service fee of \$5 to cover the cost of processing a refund. The Park District must be notified of cancellation by the register by (Reg. By) date for that program. Cancellations made after the register by (Reg. By) date are subject to a \$5 service fee, plus any costs incurred by the park district. Cancellations made with less than a 24-hour notice will not be able to receive a refund.

SATISFACTION GUARANTEED

The Lisle Park District is committed to providing the best quality programs to our participants. If you are not completely satisfied with the program after the first class, just give us a call. We will send you a "Dissatisfied Refund Form" to be filled out and returned, and after review, we can either provide you a credit that can be applied to another program, or issue you a full refund. It is that easy. Satisfaction Guarantee does not apply to trips and special events.

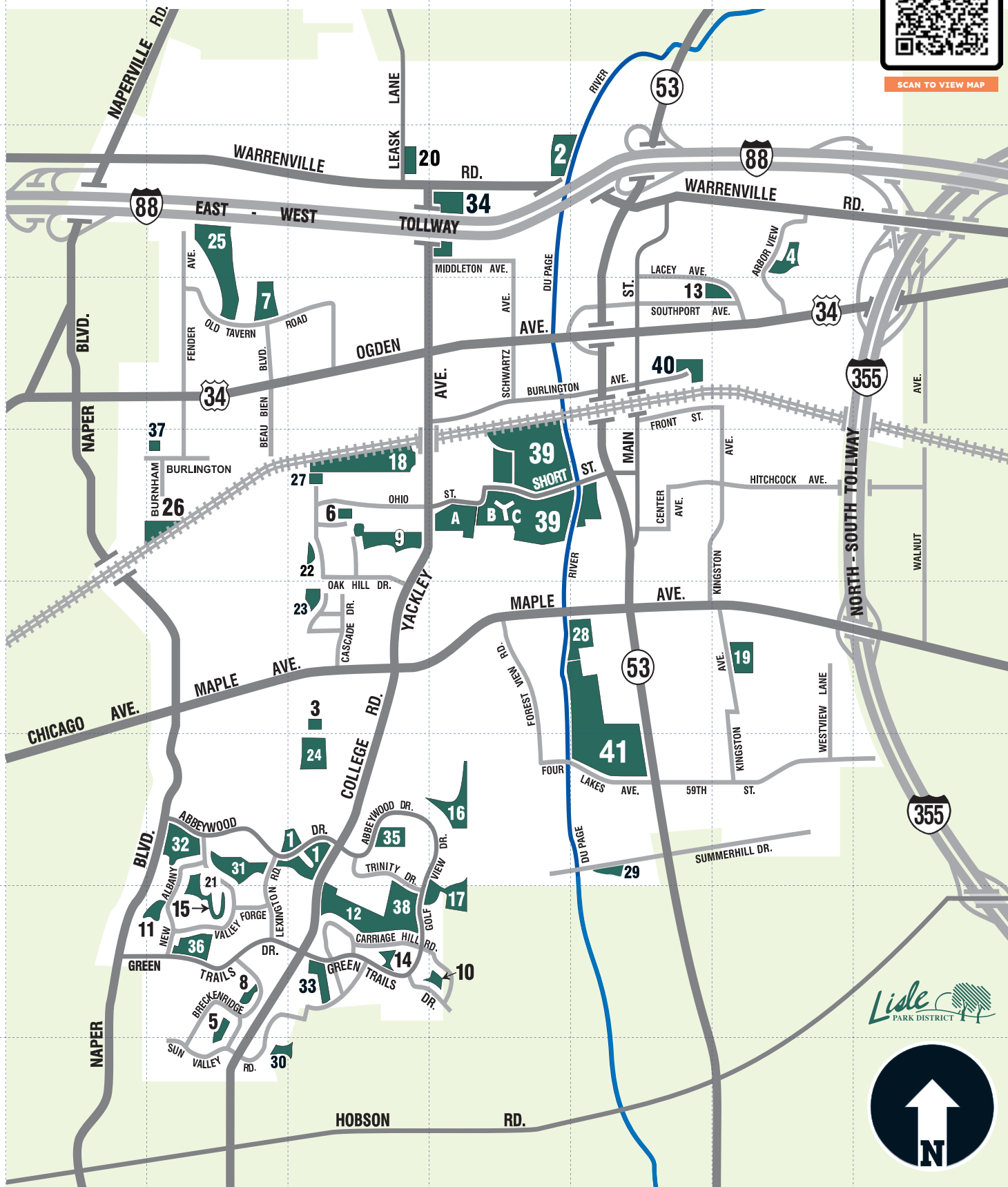
